REMINDERS

The school day

Children should arrive in school no earlier than 8.50am unless they are attending the breakfast club (available from 8.15am). There is no supervision for children arriving before 8.50am. Class starts at 9am. *Making a quick get away...*

In the interests of settling children into class and getting the school day up and running, I would ask that all parents try to drop off their child and leave promptly. Although very well intentioned, staying to settle your child can have the adverse effect of making them anxious, as well as disrupting class routines. If you need to return with lunch boxes, swimming gear etc. these should be left in the office and they will be sent on to the room from there.

After school Club

Our one pick-up club (2-3pm) & homework club 3-4pm continue daily. (£2 p/hr. Booking required).

Uniforms

Thank you to parents for your efforts in getting our pupils ready for their new school year. In particular, thanks for ensuring children are wearing black/dark shoes with dark soles and trousers/bottoms are plain & not branded. It really makes a difference to the overall appearance. All children are expected to wear jumpers or cardigans. These may be taken off if the children are too warm and put on at the end of the day – not tied around their waist. This is particularly important because as well as keeping your child warm, it also means that every child goes home with their jumper! Half-zips etc are a good substitute for a coat but are not to be worn as an alternative to a school jumper. And - very importantly – please ensure your child's name is on all items of uniform, especially jumpers and cardigans.
