Free School Meals & Uniform Allowance 2017/18

Who is eligible? If you are in receipt of one of the following benefits: -

- Income Support;
- Income-Based Jobseeker's Allowance;
- Income-Related Employment & Support Allowance;
- Guarantee Element of State Pension Credit;
- Child Tax Credit or Working Tax Credit with an annual taxable income of £16,190 or less.
- if you are an Asylum Seeker or your child has a statement of SEN & requires a special diet.

Not sure if your child is eligible?

We strongly advise that you apply and let those that know make that decision. Pick up a form from us today.

Did you know...

The budget given to a school is affected by the % of pupils receiving free school meals. So, if you apply and are successful, not only are you helping your child, but you are helping the school too!

IMPORTANT: Break, Milk & Dinner Money

Canteen Break for June is now due: £5.50

Please pay Marie immediately.

It is extremely difficult to refuse a child break but the canteen simply does not have the funds or powers to prepare food which is not paid for.
